1. Membership Update

3. Highlights of APMP General Assembly and related meetings 2013

The 29th APMP General Assembly and related activities were held from 24-29 November 2013 in Chinese Taipei, hosted by the Center for Measurement Standards of Industrial Technology Research Institute (CMS/ITRI). The meetings held were:

- The APMP General Assembly
- Executive Committee (EC) meetings, Technical Committee Chairs' (TCC) meeting, joint EC-TCC meeting
- Annual meetings of APMP's 12 Technical Committees (TCs) and the Developing Economies' Committee (DEC)
- The 4th APMP NMI Directors' Workshop on "Measurement's role in addressing global challenges and ensuring the future relevance and sustainability of NMIs"
- A Symposium on "Metrology Gearing up for Quality of Life"
- Workshops and Seminars organised by specific TCs

The General Assembly approved the following:

1) Dr Peter Fisk, CEO of NMIA, as the new APMP Chair;



- 2) Two new EC members, Dr Thomas Liew and Dr Seungnam Park;
- 3) Extension by 1 year of Dr Yukinobu Miki's service term on the EC;
- 4) The APMP Work plan and the Budget plan for 2014;
- 5) Three TC Initiative Proposals for 2014;
- 6) NIM, China, hosting GA 2015;
- 7) Signing of extended MoU between APMP and APLAC

4. Important developments

4.1 TC Initiative Projects 2014:

APMP is pleased to continue to support the Technical Committees Initiatives Program (TCI) into 2014. Five TCI proposals were submitted for 2014 and of those three were approved from the mass and related quantities (TCM), electricity and magnetism (TCEM), and fluid flow (TCFF) areas. All TCI projects are evaluated on their focus on research and development of new and innovative ideas; relevance (fit for needs) and significance to current measurement needs of industries.

4.2 APMP's role in APEC FSCF PTIN:

APLAC was the nominated Specialist Regional Bodies' (SRB) representative to the APEC Food Safety Cooperation Forum's (FSCF) Partnership Training Institute Network (PTIN) in 2013 and will act as co-representative to the FSCF PTIN with APMP in 2014.

4.3 APMP member involvement in Food Allergen Project (No: CTI 34 2013A):

APMP member, the National Measurement Institute of Australia (NMIA), is participating in APEC Project No. CTI 34 2013A titled 'Enhancing Standards, Conformity Assessment, Technical Regulations and Promoting Regulatory Cooperation in Food Allergen Management'. The related workshop took place in Vancouver, 5-8 May 2014.

4.4 APMP-APLAC Cooperation:

The APMP-APLAC Joint Proficiency Testing Working Group was recently established to develop further collaboration between the two SRBs in the organisation/coordination of joint proficiency testing programmes (PTs). The aim is to enhance and improve our regional metrological capability. The co-convenors of the APMP-APLAC PT Working Group are Dr Della Sin (APMP) and Dr Koichi Nara (APLAC) with the group comprising of five members from each SRB. Outcomes from the first meeting held in Taipei, Chinese Taipei in November include:

- Development of Terms of Reference
- Decision on composition of the WG
- Provisional Work Plan for 2014/2015



4.5 APMP-APLMF Project:

In 2013 APMP signed a MoU with the Technical Cooperation department of the German national metrology institute, Physikalisch-Technische Bundesanstalt (PTB). APMP is now working with PTB and APLMF on a new joint regional capacity building project that will run over three years. A combined PTB-APMP-APLMF planning workshop is scheduled for late May associated with APMP's 2014 midyear meetings in Indonesia (2-5 June).

5. World Metrology Day Poster

The Korea Research Institute of Standards and Science (KRISS) designed the World Metrology Day poster on behalf of APMP for this year's World Metrology Day. The theme for 2014 is "Measurements and the global energy challenge".
