- JCRB Action 31/3: Paper should be developed further with input from other RMOs
- CIPM Decision CIPM/102-44: CIPM MRA review should be the topic of NMI Directors meeting in 2015
- Working group formed within EURAMET TC-IM (EURAMET project no 1298)

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Problem/Solutions



Management of expectations:


 The reality of the CIPM MRA is different from what was intended 15 years ago. What do we have to adapt to reality?

Problem/Solutions (2)



CMC:

- We have many CMCs, should we adapt the processes or should we reduce them? What kind of tools do we have?
- The user interface to the KCDB is no longer suitable for finding the suitable information




Problem/Solutions (3)



Management of comparisons:

• The number of comparisons is too high if we follow the given procedures. Should we encourage other ways to claim CMCs, should we make comparisons easier and quicker?



Problem/Solutions (4)



Procedures and processes:

 The given procedures were established for a much smaller number of CMCs and comparisons. What kind of procedures do we need?

Draft Paper of the TC-IM working group



- Paper "Making the CIPM MRA sustainable: MRA Phase II" presented to BoD, TC chairs.... in the beginning of May
- Updated version submitted as working document to GA

Proposed solution: MRA Phase II



- We can look back on 15 years of mutual trust building within the MRA formalism
- Transition from a system of 100% checking that is building upon the trust generated in Phase I of the MRA.

MRA Phase II: CMCs



- New CMC entries are only discussed within RMO of origin
 - Appeals mechanism to be implemented
 - ➤ Alerting mechanism "What is new in the KCDB"

- Improved presentation of CMCs and search engine in the KCDB
- Critically review necessity of existing CMC entries

MRA Phase II: Comparisons



- CCs define a set of "core competences" or "anchor points", where comparisons are still performed
 - > Trust with other measurements within a certain range around the anchor point
- Number of participants in KCs is reduced
- Strict deadlines are set and enforced
- Consider concept of "on-going comparisons"
