• EUROLAB – was set up in Brussels on 27 April 1990

• EUROLAB's general objective is to promote cost-effective testing, calibration and measurement, services, for which the accuracy and quality assurance requirements are adjusted to the actual needs.

•EUROLAB represents testing, measurement and calibration laboratories in **23 European** Countries

•Grouping over **2,000** conformity assessment bodies representing **over 100,000** technical experts and laboratory practitioners.










Questionnaire on Membership of National EUROLAB Structure: EUROLAB represents these laboratories



EUROLAB Structure & Focus




Services provided by EUROLAB General Secretariat

- the Product Safety and Market Surveillance Package






Inquiry to applied metrology labs




