Part 1

G05.01 Welcome address

Zijad Dzemic, Director of the Institute of Metrology of Bosnia and Herzegovina (IMBiH) and EURAMET Delegates, welcomed the participants of the 5th EURAMET General Assembly to Sarajevo.

Zijad gave an introduction to the metrology infrastructure in Bosnia-Herzegovina (BiH) and the recent developments. He highlighted that BiH became Associate of BIPM in May 2011 and CIPM MRA is going to be signed in June 2011.

The former Director of IMBiH, Esad Tusovic, who retired a few months ago, was honoured for leading the development of metrology in BiH successfully over 30 years. Esad Tusovic thanked for the honour and directed a few words to the plenary. Janko Drnovsek, EURAMET Vice-Chairperson (GA) and Arnold Leitner directed a few words to Esad Tusovic and wished him all the best for his retirement

G05.02 Opening and Adoption of the Agenda

G05.03 Chairpersons report

G05.05 EURAMET Objectives and Strategic Matters

G05.05.01 EURAMET Strategy

During the last year a EURAMET Strategy was developed under the coordination of Kamal Hossain. Kamal recalled that the work started at the last year's GA with an enquiry among the Delegates on their benefits from and expectations to EURAMET. This enquiry together with a BoD workshop in September 2010 gave the most relevant input for the further development of the document. The document had been circulated among the Delegates ahead of the GA; positive feedback had been received. Kamal invited the Delegates to make further comments, also after the GA.

A discussion on the implementation of the strategy has started in the BoD meeting preceding this GA. Kamal invited also the Delegates to take responsibility for certain actions. For further information please see the PP presentation. The "Strategy 2020" document will be available soon for wider dissemination.

Positive comments from EURAMET Delegates and representatives of Liaison Organisations were made on the strategy document as such and the process to develop the strategy.

G05.05.02 Analysis and recommendations on national metrology infrastructure

Janko Drnovsek, Vice-Chairperson (GA) and Wolfgang Schmid, Head of Secretariat introduced to the issue with an overview on the work during the last years for a better integration of Designated Institutes (DIs) into EURAMET. As the latest activity a landscaping on national metrology infrastructure, composed by NMI and DIs, has been carried out. Conclusions of the landscaping and recommendations were presented. The draft document will be concluded within a month after the GA; all participants of the GA are invited to send further comments.

The following discussion focussed on the issue, that sometimes it can be difficult to identify which are the national standards and which quantities and measurement capabilities would be appropriate to be declared as national standards. It was concluded that this issue will require further discussions, within and beyond EURAMET, including in particular the BIPM and the Consultative Committees.



One Delegate highlighted the fact that a network of national laboratories was existing already before the launch of the CIPM MRA (in his country, but it is also the case for other countries), and that even today the network of these laboratories goes beyond the group of those DIs participating in the CIPM MRA.

G05.06 EMRP

G05.06.01 Actual Developments in the EMRP and their impact in EURAMET G05.06.02 Future of the EMRP

EMRP-Chair Jörn Stenger gave an overview on the current status and actual developments of the European Metrology Research Programme (EMRP).

In the second part he presented the actual ideas and preparations for a successor programme to the EMRP, with a proposed title "European Metrology Programme for Innovation and Research (EMPIR)". He commented that EURAMET members and the Research Council wish to achieve such a programme. Compared to the actual EMRP a focus shall be laid on innovation and technology transfer into industry in response to the Europe2020 strategy, in addition to a basic metrology science and a grand challenge part. Furthermore, a wider international cooperation should be envisaged.

G05.09 Report from the Working Session Delegates Only

Chairperson Leslie Pendrill presented the important results from the preceding GA Working Session – Delegates Only (see also attached slides).

- Montenegrin Bureau of Metrology (MBM) has been accepted as 37th Member of EURAMET
- 4 new Designated Institutes (DI) have been accepted as EURAMET Associates (A-DI). With that, the number of A-DIs in EURAMET increases to 72. The new A-DIs are:
 - HMI/IRB-SSDL (Secondary Standard Dosimetry Laboratory of the Ruder Boskovic Institute), Croatia
 - UT (University of Tartu), Estonia
 - NIVA (Norwegian Institute for Water Research), Norway
 - Roth + Co. AG, Switzerland
- The basic principles of the draft document on "National metrology infrastructure in EURAMET member countries an analysis and recommendations" have been endorsed.
- The financial report 2010 (together with the reports on internal and external audit) has been accepted by the Delegates. The Chairpersons' report has been endorsed. Chairpersons and Head of Secretariat have been discharged of responsibility for the financial year 2010.
- A budget of 251 k€ for member services in 2012 has been approved.
- A reviewed version of the EURAMET byelaws has been approved.



- The "EURAMET Strategy 2020" has been approved. The membership fees in 2012 shall be the same as in 2011.
- Kamal Hossain, NPL (UK) has been elected as EURAMET Chairperson for the period 2012 to 2015. He is now part of the BoD as Chairperson-elect and will succeed the current Chairperson Leslie Pendrill at the next year's EURAMET GA.
- Elections for the BoD have been carried out.
