



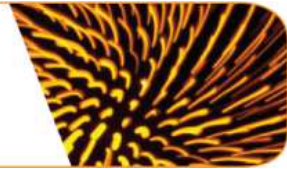
## Update to EURAMET 2015 GA on CEN and CENELEC

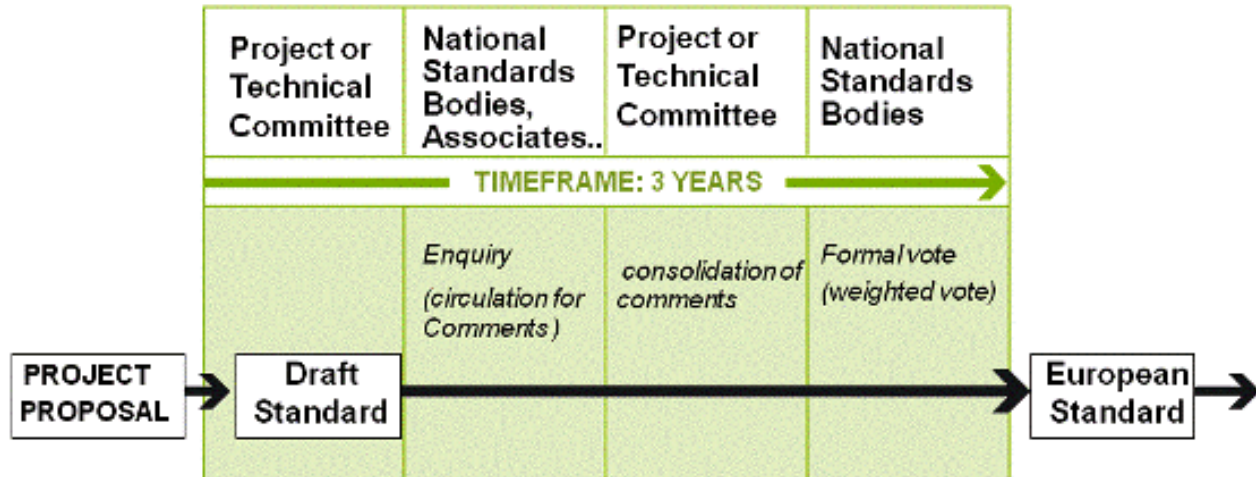
### About CEN and CENELEC

- CEN: European Committee for Standardization;  
CENELEC: European Committee for Electrotechnical Standardization
  - Two of the 3 recognized (Regulation 1025/2012) European Standardization Organizations (ESOs) to prepare *voluntary* standards that help to develop the Single European Market
  - Members: NSB/NC of 28 EU Members + 3 EFTA countries + FYROM and Turkey
  - Vienna (CEN-ISO) and Dresden (CENELEC-IEC) Agreements
- Deliverables:
  - European Standards (ENs) – a single standard for all Europe
  - But also Technical Specifications (TSs), Technical Reports (TRs) and Workshop Agreements (CWAs)

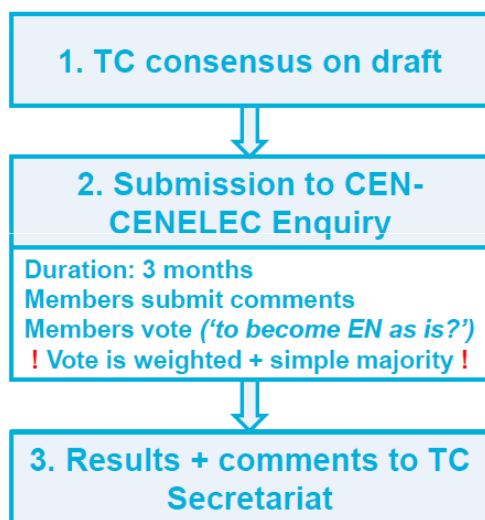
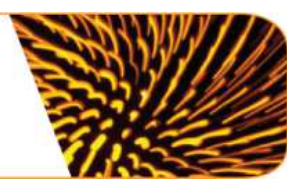


Process till 2014

# Speeding up the process – a new enquiry procedure



**If vote is positive, i.e. if**

In CEN	In CENELEC
≥ 71% of weighted votes are in favour AND Simple majority	100% of weighted votes are in favour AND Simple majority

**then**

In CEN	In CENELEC
TC can choose to skip FV (decision by simple majority) If so, standard is published as is	FV is skipped automatically Standard is published as is

**If vote is negative or if FV is not skipped**

<b>Either</b> TC handles comments TC submits doc. to FV (TC decision by simple majority)	<b>Or</b> TC handles comments TC submits doc. to 2 <sup>nd</sup> Enquiry (same features as 1 <sup>st</sup> Enquiry)

## Co-operation agreement with EURAMET



- Cooperation Agreement with EURAMET was signed in June 2010, for a period of 5 years, tacitly renewable
- Aspects of co-operation:
  - Invitations to each other GAs
  - Standardization needs feeding into EMRP and EMPIR
  - CEN/CLC BT WG STAIR and EURAMET Research Council
- Time to update agreement to reflect current situation (EMPIR, CEN/CLC Guide 25, ...)
- Updated text informally agreed
- Now to go through formal processes

## Feeding in standardization needs to EMRP and EMPIR



- 2013 EMRP energy and environment call: 11 technical bodies sent in their need; 10 projects addressing needs expressed by 3 TCs
- **STAIR EMPIR**
  - Chair: Maguelonne Chambon
  - Secretariat: Ortwin Costenoble of NEN
  - First meeting – 6 November 2014
  - *Second meeting - 17 December 2015*
  - In addition: CAG meetings
- 2014 EMPIR call: 21 standardization needs from 18 technical bodies (CEN, ISO and IEC), leading to 11 PRTs
- New contributions: process to start soon
