### ***JOINT STATEMENT on Cooperation between EURAMET and CROSQ***

#### **Options for further cooperation between CROSQ and EURAMET**

- encourage the trainees and their trainers at the European NMIs to maintain their professional and personal ties, encourage member institutions to support the trainees in follow up questions with the provision of advice and training material
- encourage the trainees to further disseminate and consolidate their acquired knowledge offering regional training courses and national training in their facilities (make use of EURAMET guidance materials)
- when appropriate, EURAMET will invite CROSQ to send participants to training courses of the Focus Group on Facilitating National Metrology Infrastructure Development (depending on resources)
- donation of equipment (which is no longer in use) from European NMIs to CARIFORUM NMIs

## EURAMET's strategy on development programmes



### Expressed interests and motivations:

some NMIs: KT, assistance for training  
development of their (typically new) institutes

some NMIs: no international development mission but interest in project participation for networking, reputation and staff development

few NMIs (PTB): part of mission, dedicated resources

### Indirect interests:

COM: harmonized Europe, cohesion  
need of qualified experts for development projects and of quality projects

EURAMET: be recognized as a European body and legal entity  
increase visibility and reputation  
help harmonize and develop intl. metrology  
Afrimets MoU

NMIs: EURAMET as a promotor and ally in national interest
