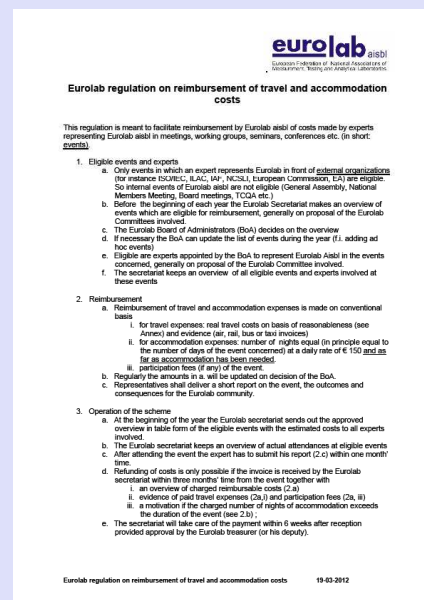

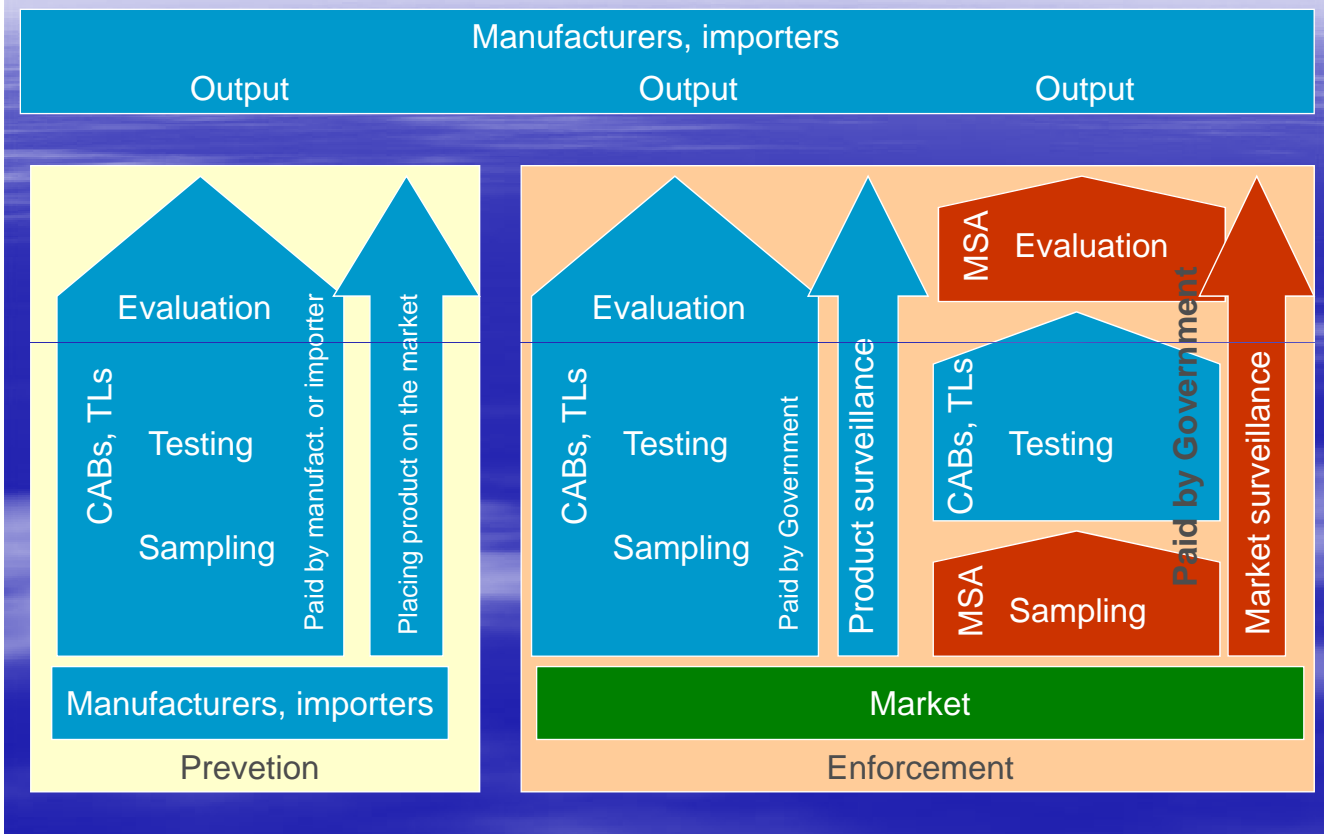

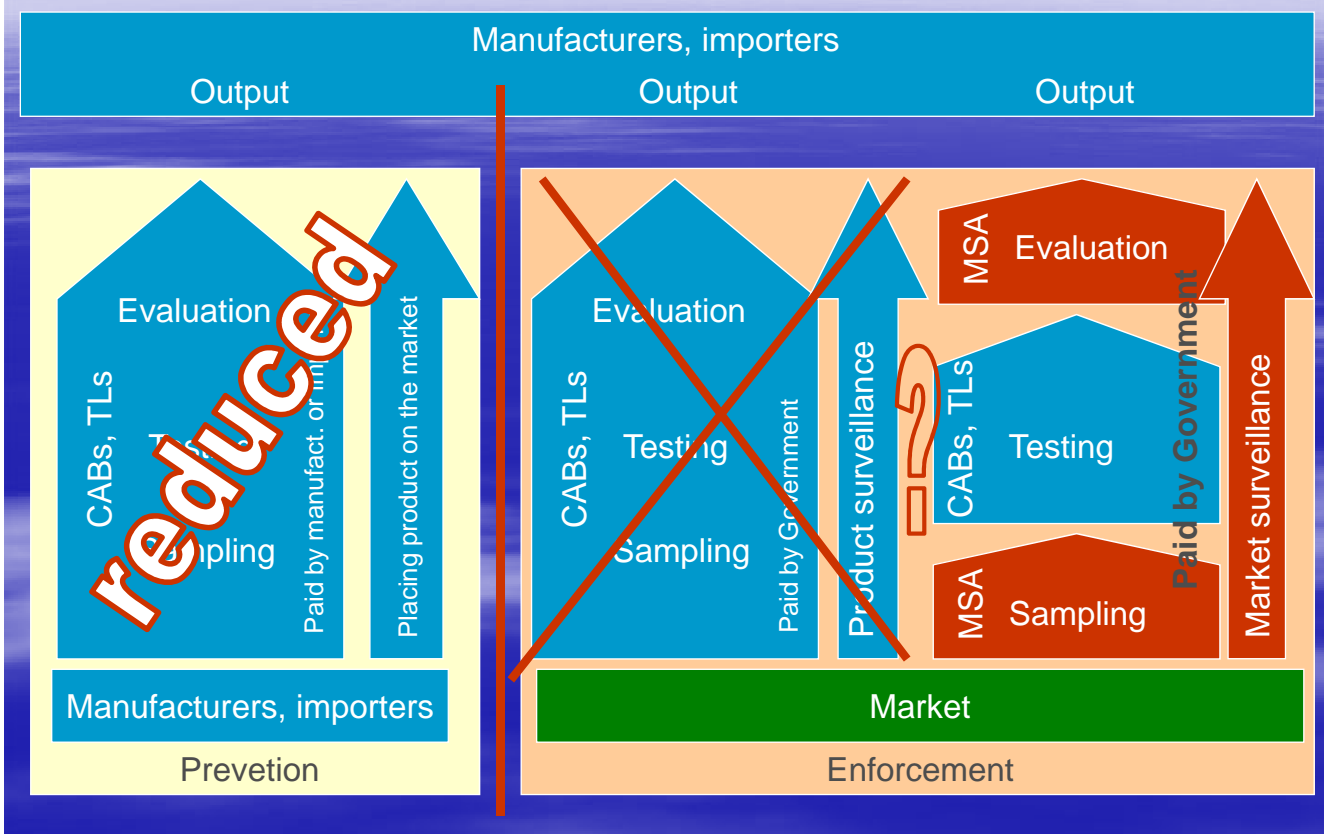

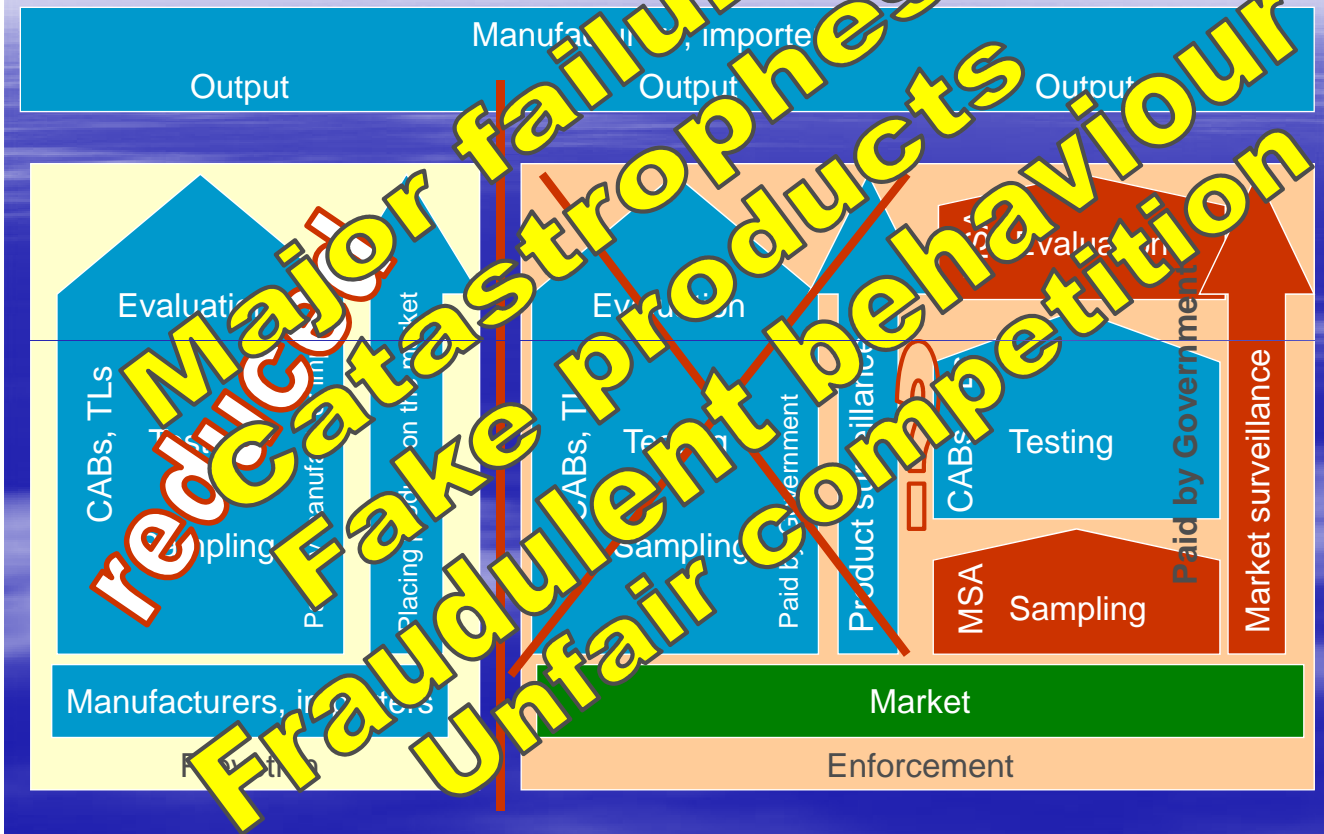
System before year 2000



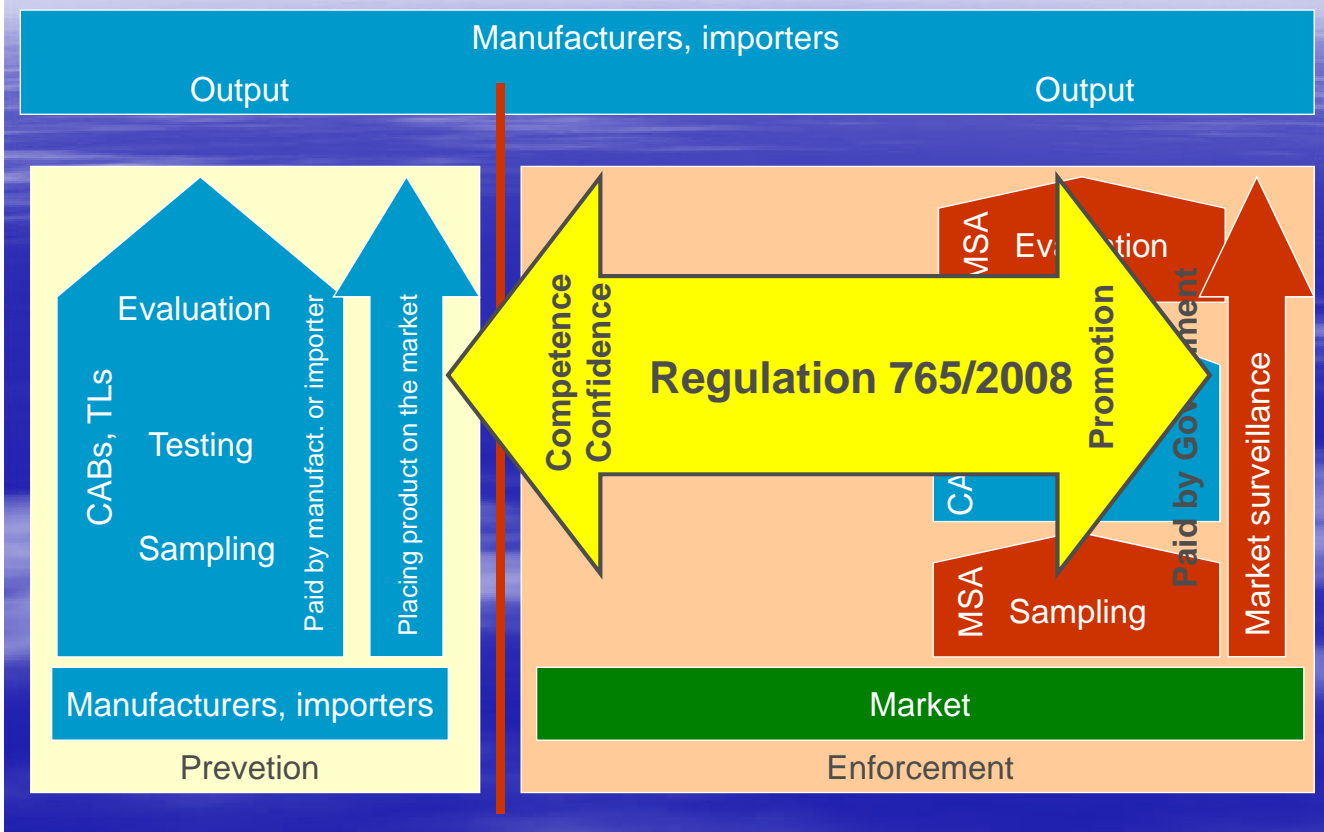
System **after** year 2000
