

Responsibilities in Legal Metrology

- European Commission
- Member states
- ▶ European/international organizations (OIML, CEN/CENELEC, EA)
- Notified bodies
- Market surveillance
- European trade organizations

WELMEC brings all parties together in order to find a harmonized implementation of European legislation, respecting the individual responsibility.



WELMEC new STRATEGY 2012

WELMEC main goals

- ▶ Raise the profile and awareness of WELMEC and legal metrology with its stakeholders.
- ▶ Facilitate the coordination of market surveillance activity.
- ▶ Enhance confidence in the operation of Notified Bodies.
- ▶ Improve the operational efficiency and effectiveness of WELMEC work.
- Facilitate the harmonized implementation of metrology directives.
- ▶ Support actions aimed at achieving equivalence for instruments in use.
- Support EU in helping neighboring countries planning to align with EU legislation.

Structure Working Group 5:

- ▶ Open session: information exchange, guides
- ▶ Closed session: AdCo, commercial sensitive.



Market surveillance

- MS makes the New Approach to work properly
- Pressure from New Legal Framework
- Not easy
- Expensive, but responsibility of the MS
- ▶ Later some financial support from EU Commission?
- ▶ How to check software version? It should be described in certificates but this is not always the case

 - Major input for OIML D31
- WELMEC Guide 2.3 (Software guide specific for weighing machines)

Recent actualisation of WELMEC Guide 7.2

▶ Guidance for the interpretation of essential requirements in the case of embedded standard operating systems of computers



WELMEC Software Activities

Currently under discussion

- Specific guidance to more effectively support market surveillance authorities
- Measures to better harmonise software-related tests among Notified Bodies (questionnaire, training)
- ► Future-oriented consideration with respect to the management of developing IT challenges (Focus: More reliance on IT standards and on manufacturer's quality management)



Future challenges in software

Guide7.2: all IT details for compliance essential requirements

- ▶ Guide is bulky
- ▶ Technical development
- Capacity of notified bodies
- ▶ Training
- Quality standards

Conclusion:

► Time to start thinking of alternative strategy for IT-related issues.



Future challenges in software

Guiding idea for future strategy:

- Require and rely on IT components in accordance with widely accepted technical rules and standards.
- Applies in particular for all-purpose components e.g. data transmission components, operating systems.
- IT components under special observation by legal metrology if fulfilling special measuring function.
