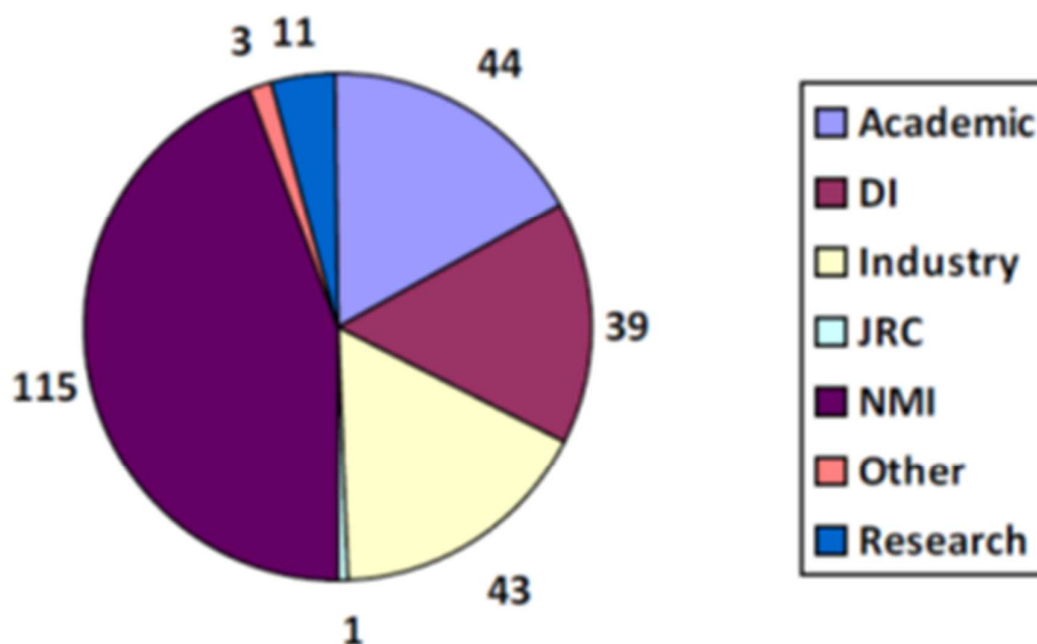

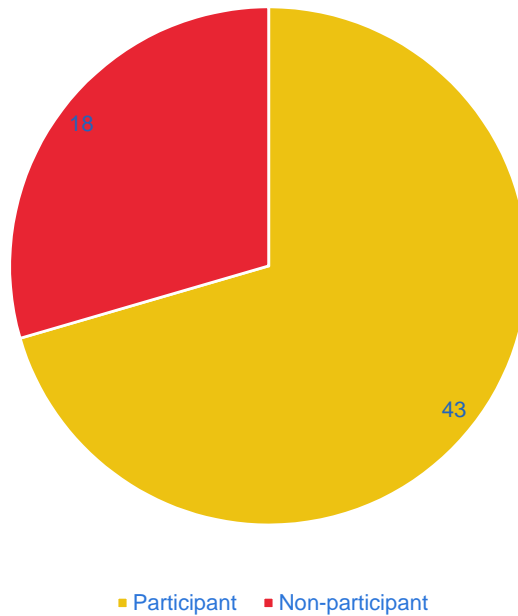
Participation in the 2014 Call selected projects

61 EURAMET DIs eligible to take part in EMRP

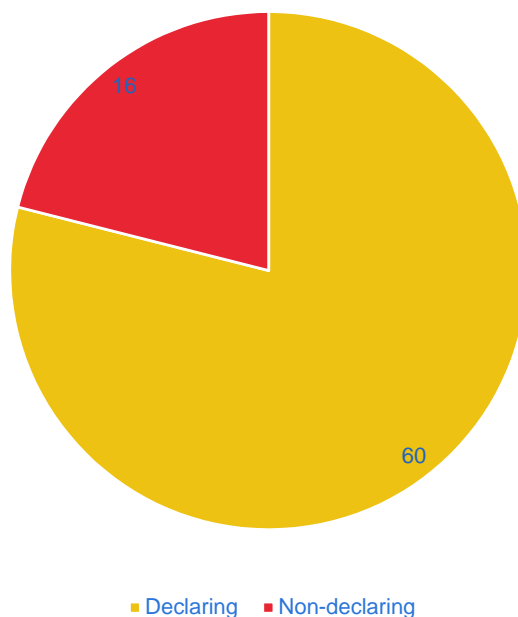

DI Participation in MRA

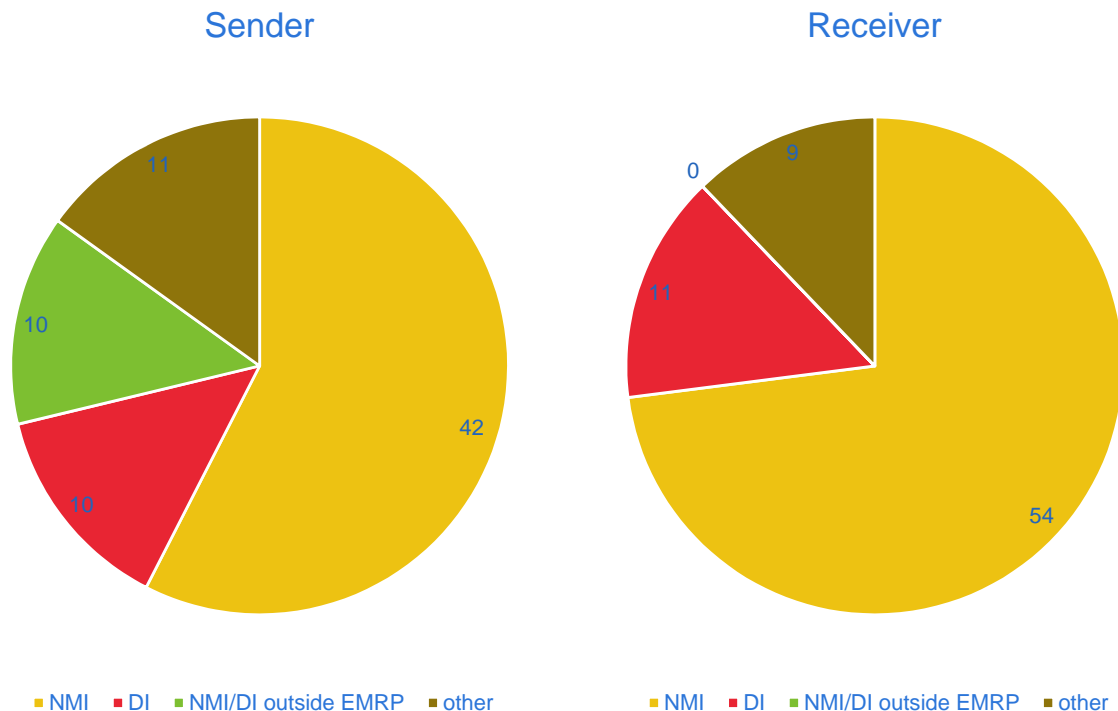

Benefits of participation in the programmes



- In EMRP, DIs (in their area of designation) participate as funded partners on the same terms as NMIs – without their designation they could only take part in Researcher Grants.
- In EMPIR, DIs (in their area of designation) participate as internal partners on the same terms as NMIs. They are funded at 105 % of direct costs. Outside their area of designation they take part as external partners and are funded at 125 %.
- Sending and receiving guestworkers through mobility grants.
- In some countries (GB, DK,) the DIs receive the national funding through additional funded contracts.
