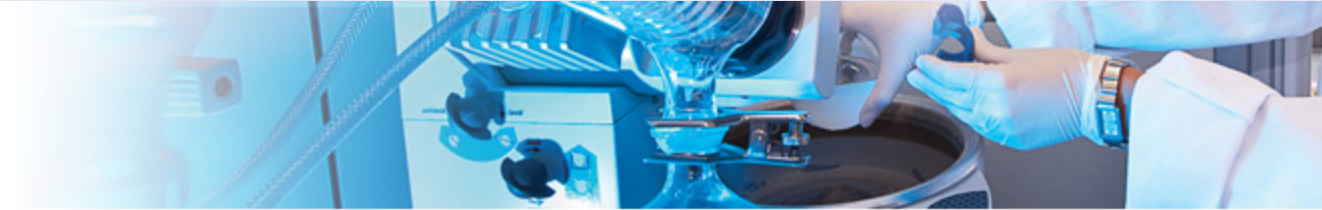

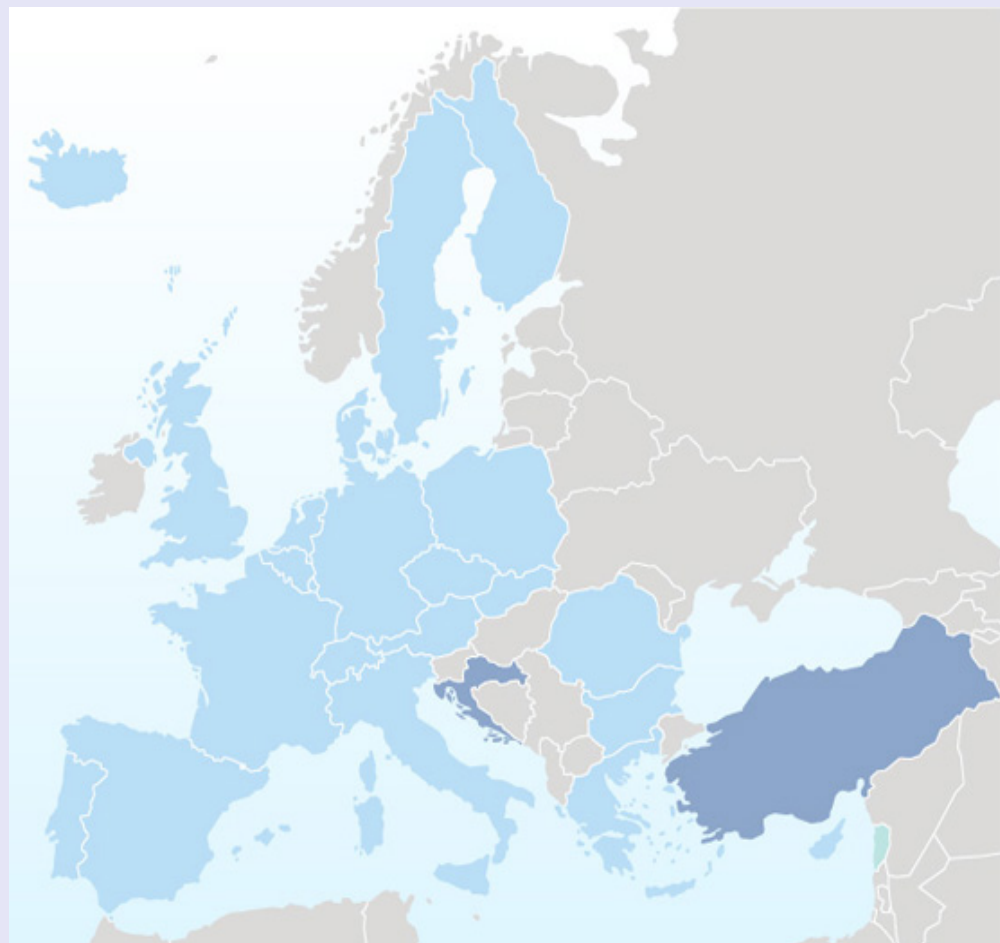
EUROLAB General Objective

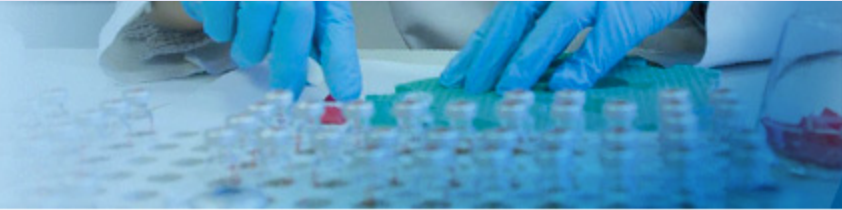

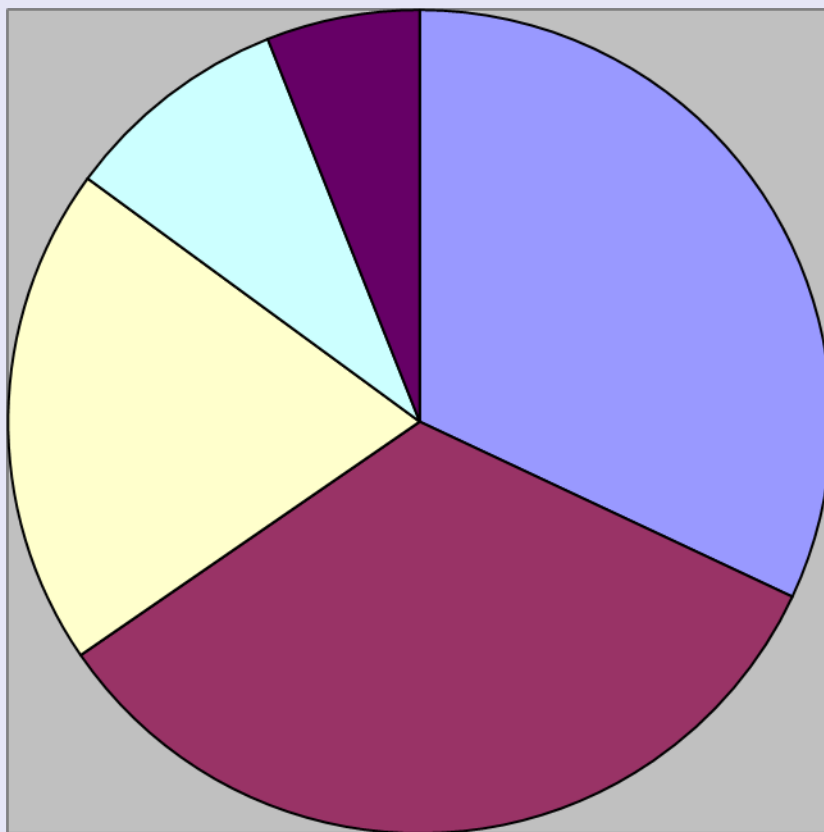

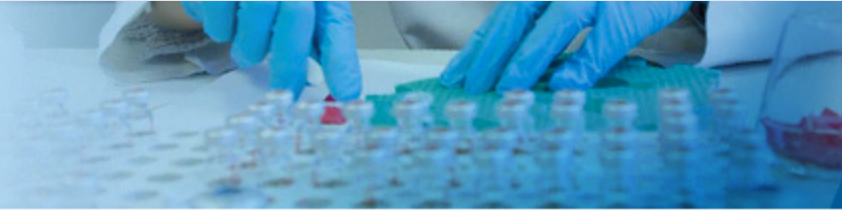


Questionnaire on Membership of National EUROLABS

Size of Membership

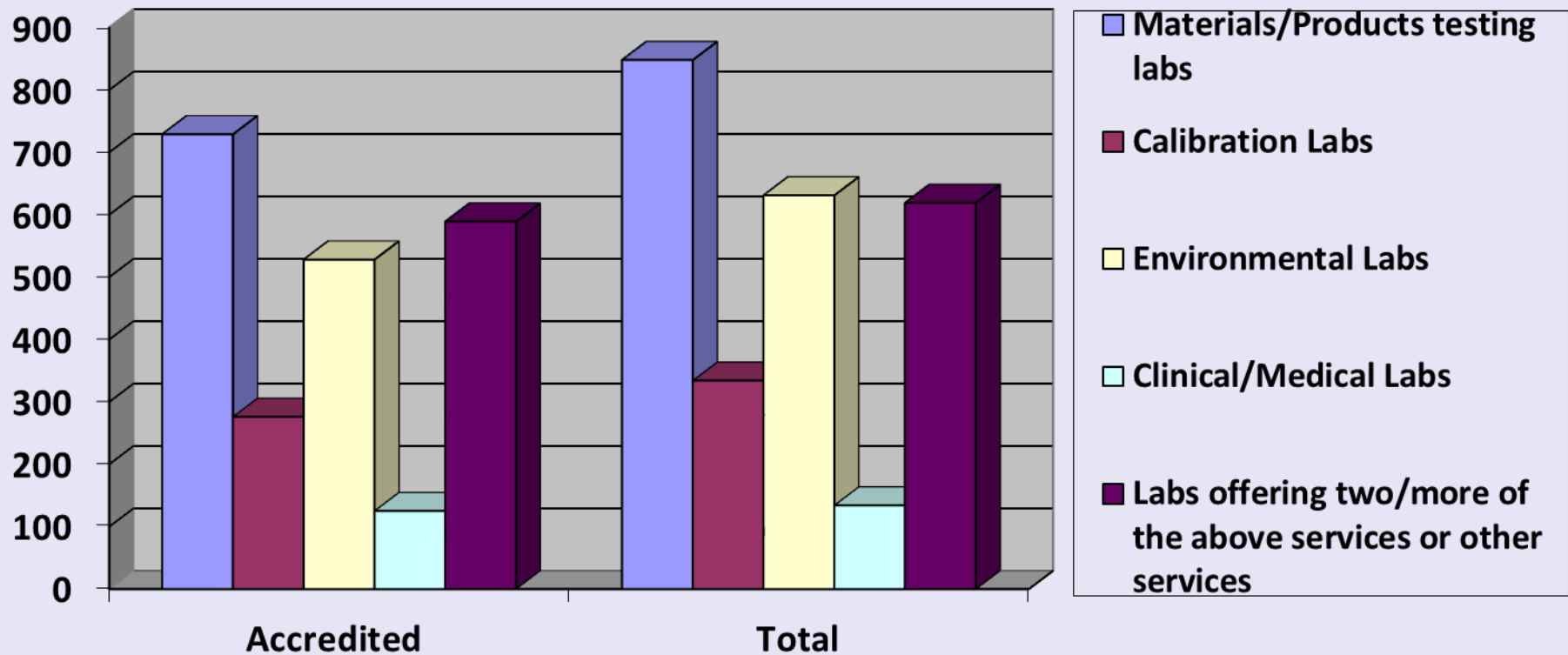


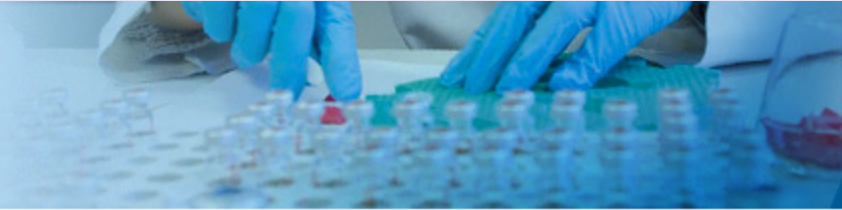

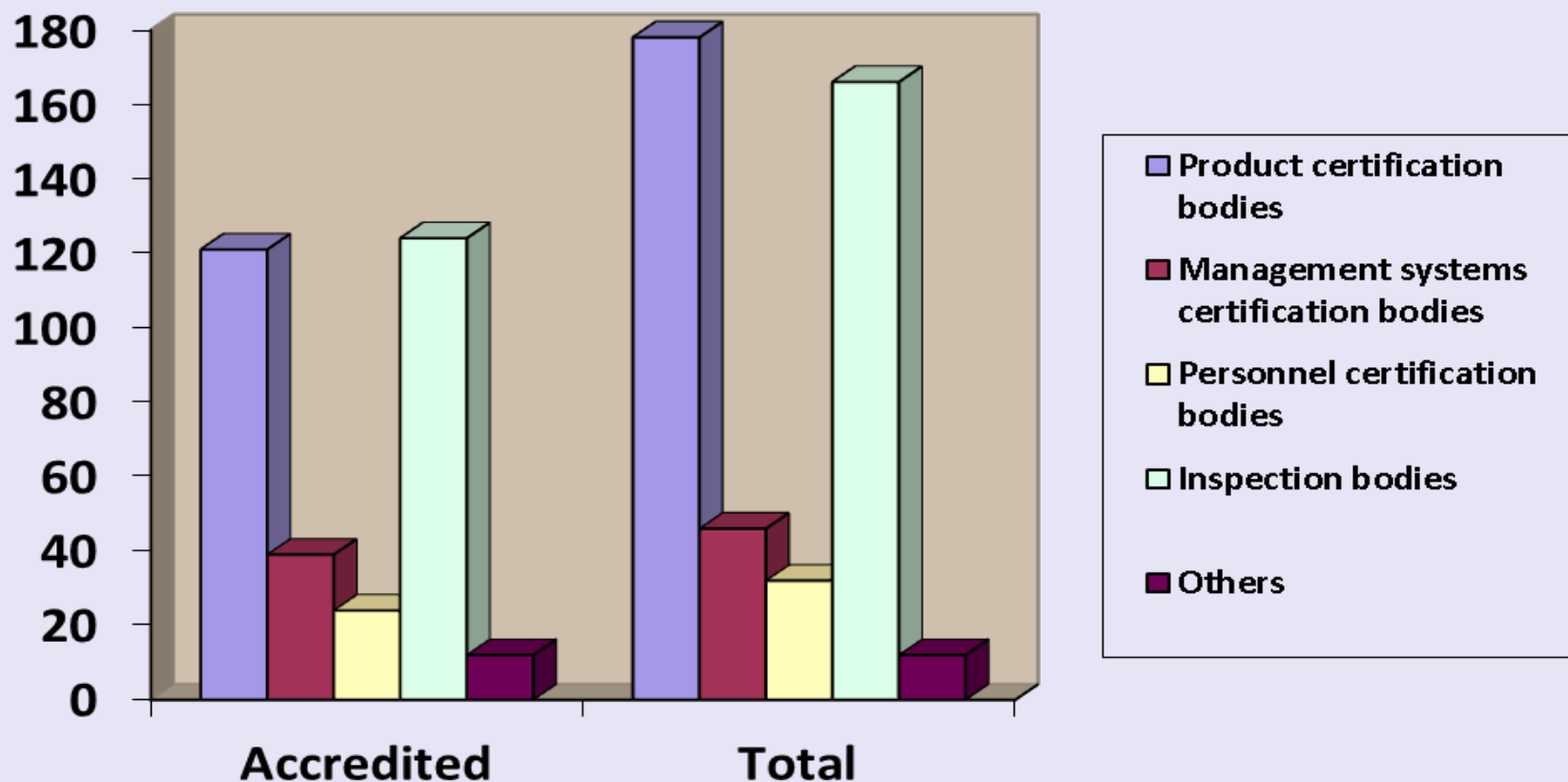
Questionnaire on Membership of National EUROLAB

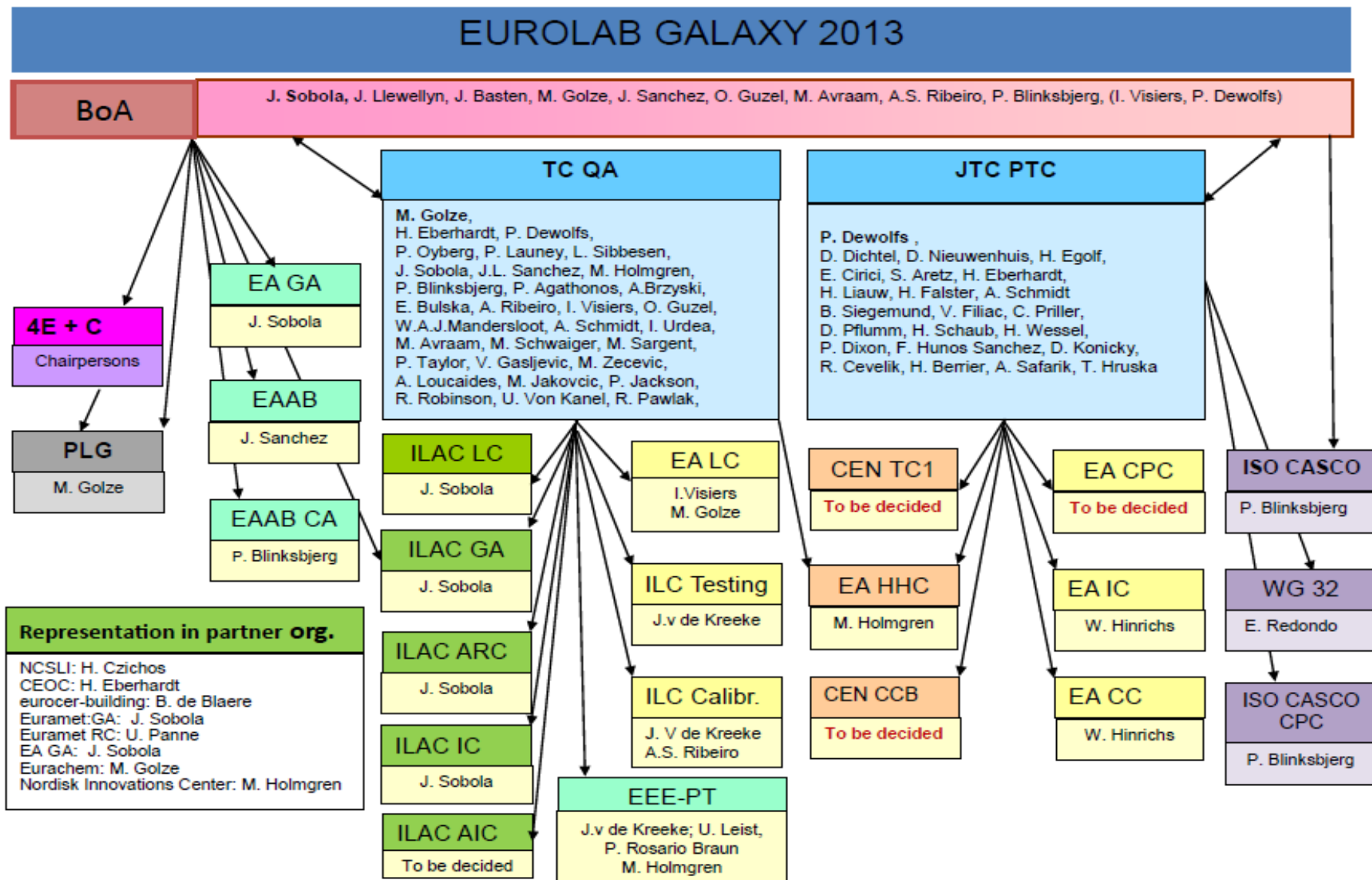

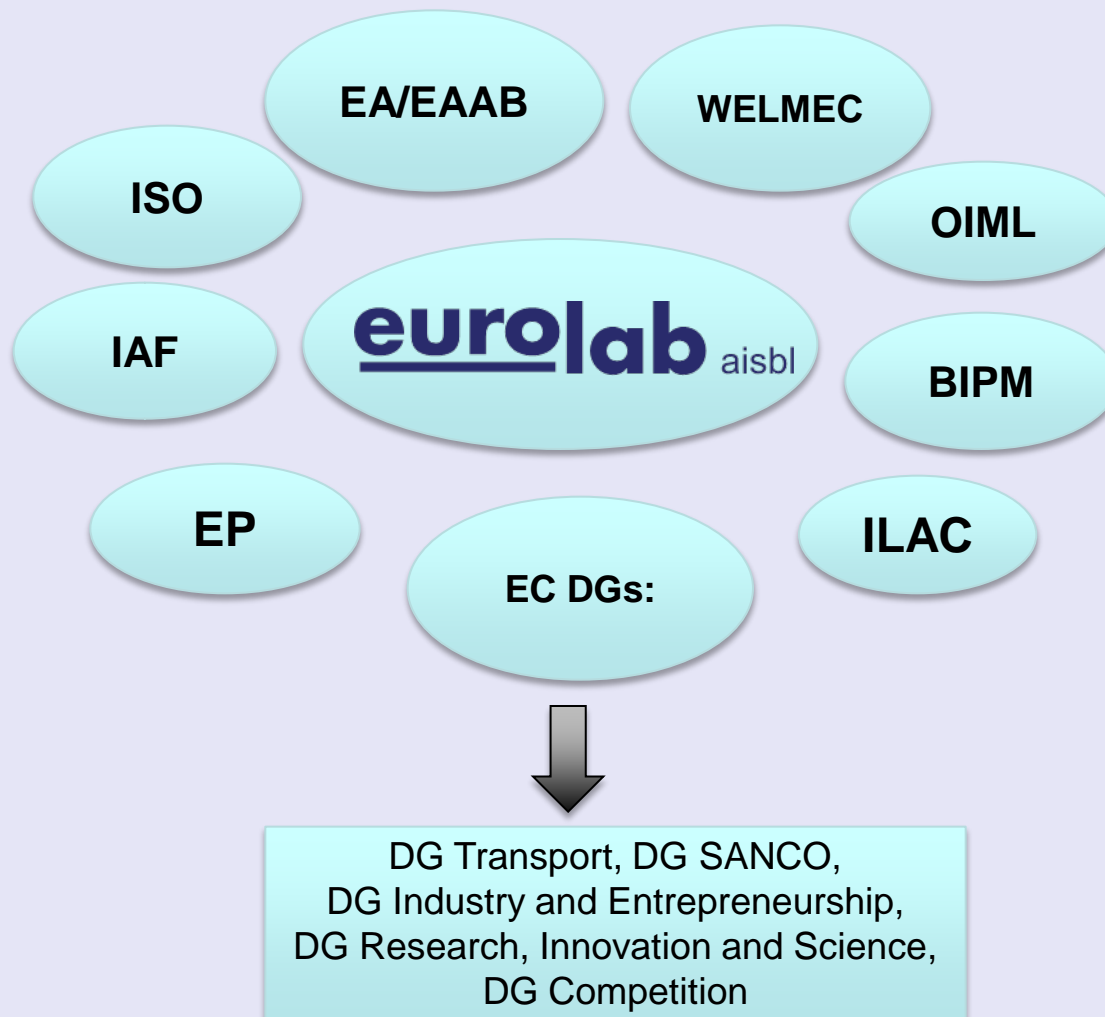

EUROLAB – Driving Forces

- The internationalisation and globalisation process forcing EUROLAB to be much **more active in the international arena**;
