

Technical work

Preliminary remarks

- Most of the technical work takes place in the Working Groups
- Role of Committee Meeting
 - Approve Work Programme
 - Final approval of prepared guides
- WELMEC considers meetings of WG as Training / Knowledge Transfer



Technical work (2)

Guides

- Guides are the main product of WELMEC EU-Regulation (MID / NAWI-Directive)
- Close link to European Commission
- Role of WELMEC recognised by EC
- MID / NAWI-Directives have both been revised
 - many WELMEC guides must be adapted



Technical work (3)

Market Surveillance

- Cross border projects
 - Non-automatic weighing instruments (NAWIs)
 - Utility meters



Organisational Work

Procedures

- Current procedures established over the years
- General revision of the procedures decided by the Committee
- Themes
 - Financial regulations
 - Election of Chairperson
 - Election of Chairperson's Group
 - Prepare for more frequent e-votes



Legal status

- WELMEC is based on Memorandum of Understanding
- Legal status unchanged since beginning
- Current challenges of the organisation related to legal status
- → Project to study potential legal forms for WELMEC



Collaboration with EURAMET

Background

- WELMEC Committee instructed Chair in 2017 to: "... explore and investigate the possibilities of closer collaboration with EURAMET..."
- Joint task group (WELMEC EURAMET)
 - Identify possible scenarios
 - Develop roadmap

Current status

- Joint task group met on 29th Nov 2017
- Developed common paper with different scenarios
- Result was presented to WELMEC Committee Meeting



Collaboration with EURAMET (2)

Scenarios

- A. Based on memorandum
- B. Two organisations, Common support structure
- c. Creation of single organisation

Discussion at CM 2018

- Many supporters of scenario B ("Seems most promising path")
- Some voices in favour of scenario C ("Do not yet drop C")



Collaboration with EURAMET (3)

Conclusions

- Work out more details for each the scenario
- Work out different options for each scenario
- Take into account opinion of CM2018
- Prepare for decision to be taken at CM2019
