


CEN and CENELEC and their deliverables







- Developed in a Technical Committee following the national delegation principle:
 - European Standard (EN) identical in 34 countries
 - Technical Specification (TS) first trail/ prestandard step
 - Technical Report (TR) informative
- Direct participation model mostly used in R&D context:
 - CEN-CENELEC Workshop Agreement (CWA) agreement between interested parties, open direct participation

all are voluntary in nature

STAIR-EMPIR



A STAIR (STAIR = STAndards, Innovation and Research) platform aims to bring together standardizers, researchers and innovators in order to discuss and identify standardization needs and opportunities for a specific area of concern.

STAIR-EMPIR was created by the CEN and CENELEC Technical Boards with the aim to bring together the metrology research and standardization communities – a chair and a secretariat

Context:

- Cooperation Agreement with EURAMET (2010, renewed end 2015)
- CEN/CENELEC BT WG/STAIR

Main activities under STAIR-EMPIR:

- Yearly submission of needs for metrology research originating from the standardization work as basis of PRTs
- Support of interactions between both communities (various ways: yearly meeting in Brussels, webinar, organizing F2F or virtual interactions between experts)
