- Signature Ceremony on 14th of May
- Signatories: CEN-CENELEC; 19 European NSBs; international standards organizations and other (open to global signatories)

- Participation of 26 representatives from 11 countries
- Agreement on the convenors and the ToRs
- Exchange of information on the EC Ethics Guidelines for trustworthy AI and on ISO/IEC/JTC1 SC42 activities.
- Discussion on a shared vision for a roadmap and the next steps

Digital Transformation: Strategy & Projects

In line with CEN – CENELEC Ambitions 2020:

Digital Transformation: Strategy & Projects

Project 1: Online Standardization

Modernization and digital transformation of standards development in CEN - CENELEC through a seamless and user-friendly environment for collaborative authoring of standards

Project 2: Future of Standards

Establish stakeholders' current and future requirements,

Adapt processes and governance in order to deliver machine-readable and interpretable standards content, in a secured way,

Set the legal framework to help the CEN-CENELEC Members to develop a business model for exploiting this digital content

Project 3: Establish Strategic Alliances

Give CEN - CENELEC the necessary tools (linkage mechanisms) and network (partnerships) to ensure an adequate and sustainable standardization response to the needs of European industry facing the challenges of digital transformation.

Project 4: Open Source

Develop an approach for linking standardization and Open Source activities: links with Open Source communities & integrate OSS in Standardization



Innovation Plan

3 main focuses

- 1. To engage with researchers and innovators through recognizing contributions from research
- 2. To offer deliverables and processes that meet researchers and innovators needs by a fast –track approach
- 3. To obtain the support and recognition of (national and European) institutions

- 'fast track process' from CWA into a consensus standard (EN)
