# Last TC-Q meeting and outcomes



**Venue: Ljubljana, Slovenia**

**Date: 17-18 April 2019**

**72 participants from 35 countries**

**Invited guests from EA LC and EURAMET Secretariat**

- 4 Initial presentations:
  - Moldova INM,
  - Albania, DPM,
  - Bosnia and Herzegovina, LABSAGAS
  - Croatia, DHMZ-SOUL

re-instatement of Albanian CMCs possible,  
after onsite peer review organized as EURAMET TC-Q  
project 1458, TC-Q chair informed BIPM accordingly  
→ re-instatement was confirmed by BIPM on 15<sup>th</sup> May

- Re-evaluation presentations from further 9 countries
    - Turkey (UME, TAEK)
    - Finland (MIKES, Aalto, MIKES-FMI, MIKES-SYKE, FGI-GG, STUK)
    - Greece (EIM, EXHM/GSCL-EIM)
    - Hungary (BFBK)
    - Ireland (NSAI NML)
    - Slovenia (MIRS, MIRS/SIQ, MIRS/UL-FE/LMK, MIRS/UM-FS/LTM, MIRS/IJS/F-2;O2, MIRS KI/L05, MIRS/IMT/LMT, MIRS/NIB/FITO, MIRS/UP-ZRS/LPOO)
- re-evaluation of MIRS/ZAG/SM 480 MIR postponed

- Further re-evaluations:
  - Italy, (INRIM, ENEA)  
ENEA announced to apply for greying out all CMC's
  - Belgium (SMD)
  - Poland, re-evaluation of GUM, INTiBS, POLATOM postponed to 2020

- Review of 104 Annual Reports from 32 countries and one international organization (IAEA)
  - Full confidence was given to 22 NMIs/DIs on spot,
  - Major complementary information was requested from FSB (Croatia), UBA (Germany), Latvia (LTMB)

This time gap analysis and action plan on transition to ISO/IEC 17025:2017 and ISO 17034:2016 was required

**2015** Guidelines on borderline CIPM MRA activities and use of ISO Guide 34

**2016** Revision of the ISO/IEC 17025 standard

**2019** ~~Transition to ISO/IEC 17025~~
