## Key activities this year



- Preparing to launch 6 EMNs
- Discussing up to 20 further ideas for EMNs
- Discussions with WELMEC on common strategic issues
- Persuading the EC to support a further metrology programme under "Horizon Europe"
- Promoting the revised SI
- Climate Observation Event in European Parliament
- ....plus all the regular work on maintaining capacity building activities, the MRA and programme processes

## Key Perfermance Indicators (2018)



- There were 9785 downloads of Euramet calibration guides in 2018
- Projects in the metrology programmes made 467 contributions to standards in 2018
- 246 non-members are part of the consortia for the EMPIR projects selected or running
- 710 peer reviewed papers were recorded by EMRP and EMPIR projects in 2018
- 83 % of Euramet DIs are involved in Euramet projects
- 79 % of Euramet DIs have CMCs approved

All these met the targets we set ourselves for 2018, except for downloads – where GDPR issues frustrated the measurement.

## The secretariat...



- Allocates and manages a research budget worth over 90 M€ every year. From first call to final audit.
- Facilitates over 50 meetings for members every year.
- Provides a comprehensive website tracking every meeting and research project, with newsletters and impact reports.
- Provides advice and training at all levels, including mobility grants.
- Has 39 members (or vacancies)
- Costs about 4.5 M€ per year
