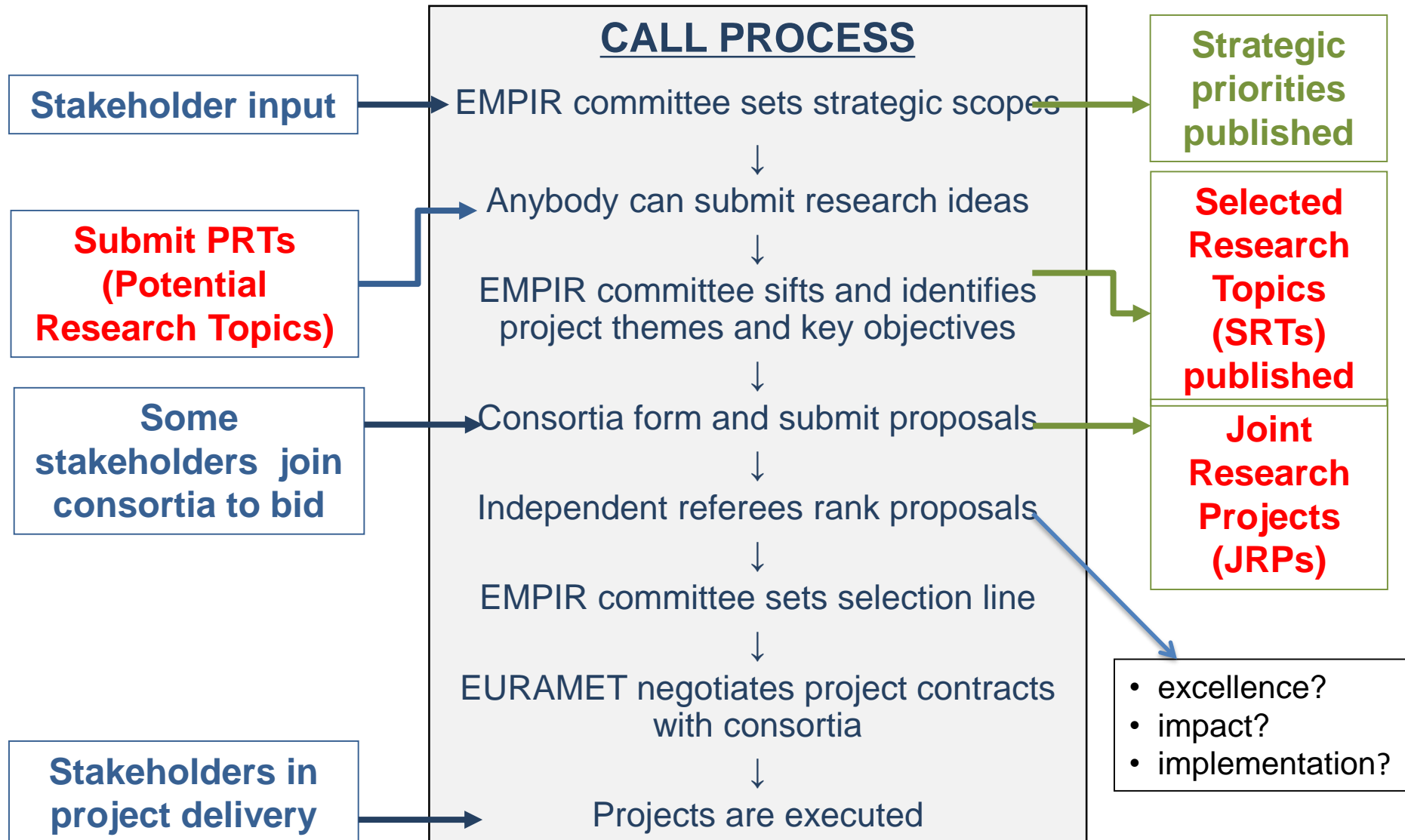
- Serves the needs of international Standards Developing Organizations, e.g. CEN, CENELEC, ETSI and ISO, IEC, ITU; as well as all other bodies regarding regulation, like WELMEC
- For **metrology** associated with establishing traceability to the SI,
- Underpins European Directives and Regulations and
- Facilitates the route to market for innovative goods and services.
- Implementation to meet short reaction requirements.
  - ✓ JRP duration = 3 years or shorter  
for extension
  - ✓ external participation up to 30 %

- Call scopes published on EMPIR website ([msu.euramet.org](http://msu.euramet.org))
- Call will be opened for PRTs on 8<sup>th</sup> January 2020 – closed 17<sup>th</sup> of February 2020

- Calls for Pre- and co-normative research projects and Support for Impact projects will run every year

- Overall budget 6 M€
- Average project size: 0.8 M€, max. 1 M€
- Call 2019: 7 projects will be funded (out of 13 published SRTs, 11 projects were competing against each other)
- Success rate for stage 2 is at least 50 %

- All NMIs (of EURAMET) can take part as internal funded partners,
- all other institutes can take part as external funded partner
- Everyone can take part as unfunded partner or as collaborator

- EURAMET funds a pilot call for Small Collaborative Projects (SCP)
- Aim: fund emerging countries in support actions
- Budget per project: 150 k€, duration max. 18 month, min. 3 emerging partners and 1 highly developed partner
- 1 Stage process, submission like the RMGs over the summer
- possible project start is spring 2021
