Consequences of war in Ukraine



- EURAMET NMIs, especially from PO, CZ, S, HU, RO, MD, offered unprecedented support, esp. All TCs are affected and responded according to the EURAMET position:
 - Concluded comparisons without RU/BY (or in process towards this)
 - No CMC reviews
 - No invitation to meetings
- COOMET members have approached EURAMET to explore options to liaise with EURAMET

EURAMET position on the collaboration with federal or public institutions from Russia or Belarus

The Board of Directors of EURAMET is deeply concerned about the Russian invasion of Ukraine and its consequences.

Based on the national and EU sanction policies, and after consultation of the delegates, the Board of Directors recommends that all EURAMET projects and activities involving federal or public institutions from Russia or Belarus are terminated, suspended, or concluded without Russian or Belarussian participation.

This recommendation applies to different types of projects and activities, such as key comparisons, pilot studies, research projects (with or without funding from EMPIR or Metrology Partnership), or CMC reviews.

EURAMET is committed to support where possible all countries suffering from the war, first of all Ukraine, but also other members of COOMET, in the short and long term.

Membership matters



- The GA accepts LNEC-UHM (Portugal) as EURAMET Associate (A-DI)
- The GA decides to maintain the status of KMA as a Liaison Organisation in EURAMET
- The Housing and Construction Authority (HMS), Iceland, transferred the operation of the laboratory to a private company, BSI á Íslandi ehf, and withdrew EURAMET membership

Decisions regarding the internal organisation and QMS



- The GA agreed on the amendments of the Byelaws and Rules of Procedure that were necessary due to the EPM
- The GA agreed on the establishment of a subcommittee on gravimetry in TC M
- The GA decided to hold the GA 2023 in Tallinn, Estonia, and thanked Aigar Vaigu for this offer

European Partnership on Metrology (-> G16.11)



- Implemented by EURAMET e.V., FFPA signed 31 March 2022
- Co-funded by EU (300 M€) and Member States (390 M€)



- to develop a sustainable, excellent and coordinated metrology system at European level
- to ensure that state of-the-art metrology capabilities are taken up by ecosystems
- to increase the impact of metrology on societal challenges

Specific objectives include:

- to develop new research capabilities which are built within the framework of new European metrology networks
- to support the use and adoption of the new metrology capabilities in key emerging and enabling technologies
- to unleash the potential of metrology among end users, including SMEs and industrial stakeholders

Create sustainable, coordinated structures in areas of strategic importance for the future of European metrology




The Networks...
