### Asia Pacific Metrology Programme (APMP) is

- An association of National Metrology Institutes (NMIs) from the Asia-Pacific region for improving regional metrology capability;
- One of the six Regional Metrology Organisations (RMOs) to implement the CIPM MRA for the worldwide mutual recognition of measurement standards and of calibration and measurement certificates;
- One of the Specialist Regional Bodies (SRBs) working with APEC to facilitate the development and implantation of standards and conformance infrastructures that addresses APEC goals.





# **APMP COVID-19 Response Programme**

- The programme was launched in 2020 and extended to 2022
- Call for proposals constantly open
- Evaluation conducted every 3 months

### COVID-19 Programme status by now

Total Budget: US\$ 250,000 for FY2020&2021 US\$ 100,000 for FY2022 (<u>USD 97,640</u> allocated by now)

#### 1<sup>st</sup> round of proposal submission

- 3 out of 4 proposals got supported

Possible metrological supports for COVID-19 crisis management

Comparison measurement and training courses on the ventilator tester

Investigation of the human speech/cough droplet size measurement and comparison for COVID-19 infection control

Accurate measurement of SARS-CoV-2 and development of nucleic acids reference material

Establish and validate national capabilities to support the growth in use of thermal imagers for public thermal screening

#### (Progress reports available on APMP website - GA 2021)

Resolution GA37-09: The 37th GA approved establishing a Focus Group on Digital Transformation in Metrology (DXFG) as a dedicated forum for regional collaborative activities relating to digital transformation in metrology, and approved the appointment of Dr Blair Hall (MSL, New Zealand) as its first Chair for a three year term from GA 2021 to GA 2024.

## Current status:

- Approximately 30 members joined the new FG, representing 12 member economies and 2 associates.
- The terms of reference, responsibilities and structure as well as strategic plan of DXFG has been developed under the leadership of Dr Blair Hall, the DXFG Chair.

# **2021 APMP NMI Directors' Workshop**

#### Foster Asia-Pacific Metrology Collaboration in a Digital World

The 12<sup>th</sup> APMP NMI Directors' Workshop was held on the theme "Foster Asia-Pacific Metrology Collaboration in a Digital World" for ideas sharing and discussions to develop a holistic understanding of metrology digitalisation and to review the preliminary work plan of the APMP Focus Group on Digital Transformation in Metrology (DXFG). The Workshop connected APMP NMI directors and invited participants virtually for a forward-oriented dialogue driven by digitalisation on 23 November 2021.

Topics that featured prominently on the agenda are: Topic 1: How is digital transformation changing NMIs? Topic 2: Key areas of digital transformation for APMP Topic 3: Regional collaboration in metrology for digital transformation

Making an Impact on Water Quality for Public Health and Safety Workshop on Building Laboratory Measurement Techniques



- The online workshop was held on 23 & 24 March 2022, 1:30-4:00 UTC *via* Zoom platform.
- Eight talks covering regulations, analytical measurement techniques, metrological traceability, conformity, uncertainty of measurement, sampling and accuracy-based proficiency tests were presented by experts from metrology institutes, water regulatory agencies, accreditation body and academia.
- Slightly over 220 participants from APEC and non-APEC economies attended the workshop on each day.
