Who is NoBoMet

- NoBoMet is the European Coordination Group of Bodies notified by the European Commission for the Directives 2014/31/EU and 2014/32/EU.
- The group is established by the European Commission based on the decision at the Working Group Measuring Instruments meeting in 2019

Article 35

Coordination of notified bodies

The Commission shall ensure that appropriate coordination and cooperation between bodies notified under this Directive are put in place and properly operated in the form of a sectoral or cross sectoral group or groups of notified bodies.

Member States shall ensure that the bodies notified by them participate in the work of that group or those groups, directly or by means of designated representatives.

2014/31/EU (NAWID)



2014/31/EU article 23 and 2014/32/EU article 27:

11. Conformity assessment bodies shall participate in, or ensure that their personnel responsible for carrying out the conformity assessment tasks are informed of, the relevant standardisation activities and the activities of the notified body coordination group established under the relevant Union harmonisation legislation and shall apply as general guidance the administrative decisions and documents produced as a result of the work of that group.

Foreseeable challenges for Notified Bodies in legal Metrology in the next 5 to 10 years

- Necessary revision of MID and NAWID
- Missing or obsolete harmonised standards
- Digitalisation (dCoC, digital workflow implementation)
- Increasing complexity at all levels (measuring instrument technologies, regulation, standardisation, accreditation processes, compliance requirements, internal processes, ...)
- Increasing time pressure
- Shortage of materials, problems with supply chains
- Lack of human ressources
