Scope

This document describes the basic conditions for the use of EURAMET publications like Calibration Guidelines, Technical Guides and booklets, and training materials by other organisations, and their distribution as organisations' own versions (secondary publication).

Rationale

To stimulate international harmonisation in metrology, EURAMET e.V. welcomes the use of its publications and training materials by other organisations, e.g. National Metrology Institutes, Regional Metrology Organisations, National Accreditation Bodies, regional accreditation organisations, calibration and testing laboratories.

Conditions

EURAMET e.V. holds the copyright on all documents and other materials developed by its staff or within its committees.

EURAMET publications and training materials may be used in the original English version or translated to a national language and distributed as an organisation's own version (secondary publication) under the following conditions:

- 1. the content must not be modified;
- 2. reference must be made to the original;
- 3. distribution in electronic and printed form must be free of charge;
- permission to distribute organisation's own versions of EURAMET documents must be obtained from the EURAMET Secretariat;
- 5. national or organisational addenda, e.g. foreword or annexes, may be added, but must be clearly recognisable as such;
- 6. the use of training materials is for internal and non-commercial purposes only.

Examples of the specific text to be included in relevant publications are given in G-OPS-INS-007 and G-OPS-INS-008.
