The TC IM, composed of one representative of each EURAMET member, addresses issues that:

- are of a cross cutting nature, or
- · not covered by a specific TC, and

thus are not best addressed by one of the other EURAMET TC's or other EURAMET bodies.

Additionally, TC-IM provides a forum and opportunity for bottom-up ideas to be explored.

TC-IM develops and maintains a running, living document capturing relevant ideas, current and potential activities. In this respect, TC-IM welcomes (beyond the regular input channel from NMIs) suggestions from the TCs and the other EURAMET bodies, especially from BoD and GA.

The TC-IM maintains close contact with and regularly reports to BoD.

The TC IM chair is standing invitee in the Board of Directors.

Activities are typically executed in the form of projects, which are launched when sufficient interest exists and appropriate resources are available. The projects, chaired by a TC-IM member, may include wider participation from outside TC-IM.
