HOW TO REACH BEV BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Tickets can be purchased at the tobacconist's (Tabak Trafik) or at automatic ticket machines at metro stations (coins, notes and cards will be accepted). A single ticket (Einzelfahrschein) can be used to travel once in one direction. You may change between tram, bus and metro as often as you like, but without interrupting your travels. Don't forget to validate your ticket!

From "Schwechat Airport" to the BEV:

CAT (City Airport Train) to "Wien Mitte" or S7 (train) to "Wien Mitte" Metro "U4" towards "Heiligenstadt" to "Schottenring". From the station take the elevator direction "Herminengasse". Get out of the elevator, turn left, go few meters, to the street "Schiffamtsgasse", turn into "Schiffamtsgasse" you reach the entrance of the BEV.

From "Hauptbahnhof" to the BEV:


Metro "U1" (red line) towards "Leopoldau" to "Schwedenplatz" and change to

Metro "U4" (green line) towards "Heiligenstadt" to "Schottenring".

From the station take the elevator direction "Herminengasse". Get out of the elevator, turn left, go few meters, to the street "Schiffamtsgasse", turn into "Schiffamtsgasse" you reach the entrance of the BEV.

Getting around in Vienna:



Time zone

Vienna is in the Central European Time zone (CET = GMT / UCT + 1). Daylight saving time applies from the last Sunday in March to the last Sunday in October (CEST).

Electricity

The typical mains voltage for households (as well as hotels) in Vienna is 230 volts (alternating current)

Telephone

The telephone prefix for calling Vienna from other countries is: + 43 1

Language

German is spoken in Austria, and the most commonly spoken foreign language is English.

Climate and temperature

May is one of the best times to visit Vienna at the peak of the pleasant spring season. The city comes alive with music, people, and festivals with the warmth of the daily 8-hour sunshine. The temperatures are in the mild 12,8° C (55° F) to 21,1° C (70° F) range with sunny and bright conditions. Showers are regular in the afternoons as Vienna registers a moderate 61 mm (2,4") of rainfall in May. Expect visitor numbers to rise in Vienna with every passing day in sunny May.

Tap water

The drinking water in Vienna is of good quality and can be drunk directly from the tap.

Business hours

- Banks are usually open Monday-Friday, 8 am 3 pm.
- Shopping: Most shops are open Monday Friday 9 am 7 pm.
 Saturday 9 am 6 pm. Most shops are closed on Sunday.
- Most restaurants are open until late evening.

Legal holidays

On Thursday, May 18 (Ascension Day) banks and shops are closed in Austria.
