# 1 Reporting of the cofounding cost related to the described activities of part E of the annual report

### 1.1 Definition of the National cofounding costs of the programme

This document provides information on completing the National Cofunding financial Report, which is a mandatory annual report to be submitted by EURAMET by the National Cofunding Coordinators of all countries contributing to the European Partnership on Metrology (Partnership). This Report provides information on reporting costs of the activities described in the technical report which had been submitted from EURAMET by end of February this year..

The Cofunding Financial Report is an electronic report detailing costs occurred based on activities performed by the NMIs and DIs of the reporting country as these costs counts towards national cofunding of the Partnership.

In the most general sense, activities whose costs count toward national cofunding of the Partnership are those performed by NMIs and DIs that are funded from national resources – i.e. governmental and other public funding agencies and which can be related to the subject areas of at least one EURAMET European Metrology Network (EMN) or Technical Committee (TC).

The costs incurred should be recorded and reported in accordance with European Partnership on Metrology Cofunding Reporting Strategy.

The resource categories are:

- Days
- Labour
- Travel & Subsistence
- Equipment (depreciation and loan fees only)
- Other Goods and Services
- Internally invoiced Goods and Services


This Report should not be seen as a fully comprehensive list of all NMI and DI costs that are funded from national resources but should generally provide a compendium of costs that is proportional to the size of the reporting country's national commitment to the Partnership and its reported costs of cofunding activities for the year.

No costs funded within the Joint Research Projects and Joint Network Projects of the Partnership or EMPIR, other Horizon Europe projects, or by commercial clients are included in the report.

Each cost reported fall under one of the resource categories listed above and be credibly relatable to the activities of one EMN, or as a second option, a TC. Membership in an EMN is not a precondition for linking costs to it, provided that the cost and its activity is aligned with the scope of the EMN.

# 1.2 Costs reported and its breakdown

11 out of the 23 countries participating in the Partnership participated in this year's cofounding reporting completely, 6 have reported costs, but awaiting their CFS and 6 are yet to report.






