The Environment Targeted Programme will focus on research for robust and stable measurement for monitoring the climate and research into innovative new systems and technologies that precisely assess environmental impacts. A call for Joint Research Projects will be opened in 2016. The European Metrology Programme for Research and Innovation (EMPIR) will launch a call for Joint Research Projects (JRPs) in 2016 on the topic of Environment.

A one day workshop is announced as an opportunity to present and discuss ideas and facilitate the sharing of Potential Research Topics, prior to the next EMPIR Environment call.. Interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary ideas and inputs are expected from speakers from National Metrology Institutes and Designated Institutes. The workshop is open to external participation interested in the aims and objectives of the call.

The workshop will be opened by the EURAMET Task Group "Environment" members, presenting the work on preparation of the EURAMET Strategic Research Agenda and the ENV Call Scope. Keynote lectures from the stakeholders community will complete the opening session. The event will be based on oral presentations and round table discussions; the host organisation INRiM will provide rooms for a possible second day of meetings, in case it will be requested, in advance, by the participants.
