Venue information:

The EURAMET Spring Camp on Digitalisation will take place at the [Slovak Institute of Metrology \(SMU\)](#) in Bratislava. SMU is [located](#) 20 min from city center easily reachable by public transportation.

The transportation from city center to SMU:

We recommend using as the start of the travel the tram stop “[Most SNP](#)” take the tram No. 4 in direction “Dubravka” and disembark on the stop “[Kútiky](#)” the trip should take approx. 20 min. From the tram station [SMU is located](#) on the left side in the direction of the tram across the road. In case of using other routes we recommend using the [official public transportation planner](#).




Fig. 2 Location of SMU from tram stop “Kútiky”

Getting to Bratislava by plane:

In general you can reach Bratislava by two airports:

1. Vienna International Airport (RECOMMENDED AIRPORT)

When travelling from Vienna Airport, you can get to Bratislava either by Taxi or Bus.

▪ **By Taxi:**

Taking a taxi to Bratislava is the most convenient way of transportation. The average price of a taxi ride from Vienna airport to Bratislava is ranges from 90 € to 120 €. Note the travel time is approximately 45 minutes (depending on traffic). Vienna airport taxis do not have an official fixed price for the journey to Bratislava.

▪ **By Bus:**

There are 3 private bus companies (FlixBus, Slovak Lines, RegioJet) that provide regular transfer services from Vienna airport to Bratislava's city center, which is called "Bratislava - Most SNP", or to Bratislava Airport usually every 30 minutes.

All bus companies have similar pricing. Regular one way tickets cost from 5 € to 11 € and the journey takes approximately an hour. You can purchase your bus tickets either straight from the bus driver or online (recommended). In order to find the bus platforms just turn right after you leave the arrivals hall and follow the bus signs. We recommend you to get off the bus from Vienna Airport at station "Most SNP", which is nearby most of the suggested hotels and the city center.

2. Airport Bratislava, a. s. (BTS) - Letisko M. R. Štefánika

Nearest airport is [Letisko M. R. Štefánika](#) – Airport Bratislava, a. s. (BTS)

▪ **By public transportation:**

To get to city centre, use bus No. 61 from Airport Bratislava in the direction **Main Railway Station** "Hlavná železničná stanica". Then you need to get off the bus at station "Trnavskémýto" (duration approx. 24 min) and take a tram No.4 and get off at stop "Most SNP".

▪ **By Taxi:**

To get to the city centre from the Airport Bratislava using TAXI, prices ranges from aprox. 20 € to 35 €, if you order a taxi in advance.

Public transportation

The public transportation ticket can be purchased directly on the stops in ticket machines (card and cash payment), by SMS* or directly on the tram by card. We would recommend buying either single full fare ticket 30 min for zone 100 and 101 (2 zones) for 1,10 € or all day full fare ticket 24h for zones 100 and 101 (2 zones) for 4,80 € (more convenient).
